🐞 NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCIES 🐞 PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Grover Beach encourages residents to apply to serve on City Commissions and Committees. When vacancies occur, the City actively recruits for applicants by publishing Notices of Vacancies in the local newspapers, posting the notice in the City's three (3) public posting locations, as well as the City website and Government Cable Access Channel 20.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that:

•THE CITY OF GROVER BEACH IS CURRENTLY SEEKING CITIZENS INTERESTED IN SERVING ON THE GROVER BEACH PLANNING COMMISSION.

Two (2) seats on the **Planning Commission** are now open. One position is an unscheduled vacancy. The person appointed to this position will fill the remainder of the term until May 31, 2014. The second is for a four-year term, scheduled to expire on May 31, 2016. Planning Commission terms are normally four-year periods, with no term limits.

Interviews with interested applicants are typically held before a City Screening Committee, with recommendations forwarded to the City Council for consideration and appointment at a regular City Council meeting. Applicants must be registered voters of the City of Grover Beach.

The Planning Commission is a body of seven citizens that meet on a monthly basis, usually the second Tuesday of each month. The Planning Commission is a planning agency authorized by law to grant or deny land use approvals. The Planning Commission also reviews and makes recommendations on the community's General Plan. Major areas of involvement are real estate development projects and business uses.
