# Your Measure K TAX DOLLAR\$ AT WORK!

Weekly Construction Update: November 6, 2017

The City is continuing the multi-year project to rehabilitate streets utilizing voter approved bond funds generated by Measure K. To date the City has expended approximately \$6 million of the total \$48 million project budget on previous contracts for street repair. The current contract will expend approximately \$7 million. 1. The City will be conducting the following water system work over the next two weeks:
  - Abandonment of 2" diameter water main on **North 16th Street**, between Brighton Avenue and Newport Avenue on Thursday, November 16th;
  - Replacement of a valve in the **1600 block of Mentone Avenue** on Friday, November 17th; This will require temporary water service shut downs. Notifications will be distributed in advance to affected properties.
2. Construction of new accessible curb ramps on **Mentone Avenue**, between South 5th Street and the eastern City Limit, and on **3rd Street**, between Long Branch Avenue and the northern City Limit will continue for several weeks. Expect minor traffic delays while the work is being performed.
3. Construction of a new drainage swale on **South 13th Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Long Branch Avenue will occur over the next two weeks. Expect minor traffic delays while the work is being performed.
4. Paving of **South 8th Street**, between West Grand Avenue and Farroll Road, is expected to begin on Monday, November 20th and will continue for several weeks. Expect significant traffic delays while the work is being performed. The road will be closed to thru traffic, but remain open for residents and businesses. Trash and mail service will continue without interruption. Residents of South 8th Street are encouraged to park on side streets while construction is occurring.
5. Asphalt pavement work is expected to begin on **Mentone Avenue** and on **3rd Street** following completion of South 8th Street work.

This status update is intended to inform the public on the status of the Measure K-14 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project. Field conditions and work progress are monitored daily and are subject to change daily. As a result, the dates indicated in this update are also subject to change. Schedule and location information is most accurate within three weeks of the date of this posting. Information will be updated weekly.
