Weekly Construction Update: Week of October 1, 2018

The City is continuing the multi-year project to rehabilitate streets utilizing voter approved bond funds generated by Measure K. More information regarding Measure K and future projects can be found on the City's website which may be accessed by following the link below:

1. The following work will take place on Long Branch Avenue, between South 3rd Street and South 10th Street, over the next two (2) weeks:
  - Installation of decomposed granite walkways, the placement of mailboxes, and the relocation of traffic signs will be complete this week.
  - Pavement striping is scheduled to occur the week of October 8th.
  - Minor tree trimming to meet required street and sidewalk clearance will occur on October 11th.
2. The following work will take place in the northwest section of the City over the next two (2) weeks:
  - Pavement striping will be complete this week.
3. The following work will take place on Newport Avenue, east of Oak Park Boulevard, over the next two (2) weeks:
  - Relocation of a fire hydrant will be complete this week.
  - Work on underground water utility lines, requiring an 8-hour water shutdown, will occur on Tuesday, October 9th. All affected residences will be notified prior to the water shutdown.
  - Minor tree trimming to meet required street and sidewalk clearance will occur the week of October 8th.
  - Removal of asphalt roadway is scheduled to occur the week of October 15th.

This status update is intended to inform the public on the status of the Measure K-14 Street Rehabilitation and Repair Project. Field conditions and work progress are monitored daily and are subject to change daily. As a result, the dates indicated in this update are also subject to change. Schedule and location information is most accurate within three weeks of the date of this posting. Information will be updated weekly.
